

# SCCC/EPA Sponsored Landfill Personnel Seminar

*December 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> 2018*

SCCC and the Solid Waste Training Institute are proud to offer an EPA sponsored landfill personnel seminar. Bannock County Landfill has graciously offered the use of their conference room at the Administration Building for the seminar. The Bannock Landfill address is 1500 N Fort Hall Mine Rd, Pocatello, ID 83204.

This course is sponsored by the EPA through various scholarships and is being offered at the low rate of **\$75.00 per student for 2 days or \$39.00 for 1 day**. (Lunch and refreshments included). These scholarships are already in place for Idaho landfill personnel. Additional EPA Scholarships are available and, if qualified, can be used to waive the remaining \$75.00 course fee. We are currently working with SWANA to obtain CEUs for this course. If interested in SWANA CEUs or additional EPA Scholarships, please contact Dave Lore at 435-919-6119 for details.

## To receive the training at no cost the requirements are as follows:

Being an EPA sponsored seminar, there are a few EPA requirements which are as follows:

- At the end of the two-day seminar, each attendee will be tested on all the material covered. Those attendees who do not pass will be retrained and will receive additional training before being retested. Additional time is set aside for retraining and retesting during the second day's schedule. After passing with a minimum score of 70%, each attendee will receive a certificate of completion for the course.
- Attendees must commit to a sustainability conference which will be conducted over the phone one month after the seminar. This provides students an opportunity to report back on ideas for operational changes that may improve health and safety, are environmentally friendly, and provide a cost savings to the facility. During the seminar we will collectively discuss ideas, with each attendee being mentored on how to evaluate and possibly present these ideas to management.

This seminar consists of lectures, class activities, exercises and course materials centered on the topics of landfills, compost, HHW, food waste, recycling, and scale house operations. The seminar will also discuss sustainable operations, regulatory requirements, health and safety, diversion, recycling, cost saving measures, and options for onsite reuse. Attendees will learn how to effectively communicate and overcome the challenges posed in planning and operating integrated solid waste management systems.
